



Local Mental Health Resources

Please follow the steps below if your ARC primary care team has referred you to a psychiatrist, psychologist, social worker, psychiatric or mental health nurse, or licensed professional counselor.

STEP 1: CALL YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY

Contact the Member Services department for your insurance company at the number on the back of your insurance card or visit your insurance company's website for a list of in-network mental health providers.

STEP 2: KNOW WHAT YOU NEED

For a counselor/therapist, search for someone who has a PhD, LPC, MSW, LCSW, or LMFT in their credentials.

For a psychiatrist, look for a MD or DO in their credentials. Advanced practice clinicians (APCs) with PMHNP or FNP credentials can also prescribe.

HAVING A HARD TIME?

If you have any challenges finding a mental health care provider or getting an appointment with one, follow the below recommendations:

- **For plans purchased through an employer,** please reach out to your employer's HR department to discuss options like the Employee Assistance Program (EAP) and in-network options.
- **For Medicaid clients,** please contact your social worker or your local Health and Human Services department.
- **For plans purchased through the Healthcare Exchange,** please contact your plan administrator.
